Population and household data from 1970 thru 2010 are from the U.S. Census Bureau, as is the labor force data from 1970 thru 2000. Labor force participation rate data for 2010 is an estimate by the Maryland Department of Planning based on 2008-2012 American Community Survey data. 1990 race and sex population is from modified age, race, sex data (MARS) and 2000 race and sex population from modified race data, both from the U.S. Census Bureau. Historical jobs, total personal income and per capita personal income data are from the U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis.

Projections are rounded, therefore numbers may not add to totals.
