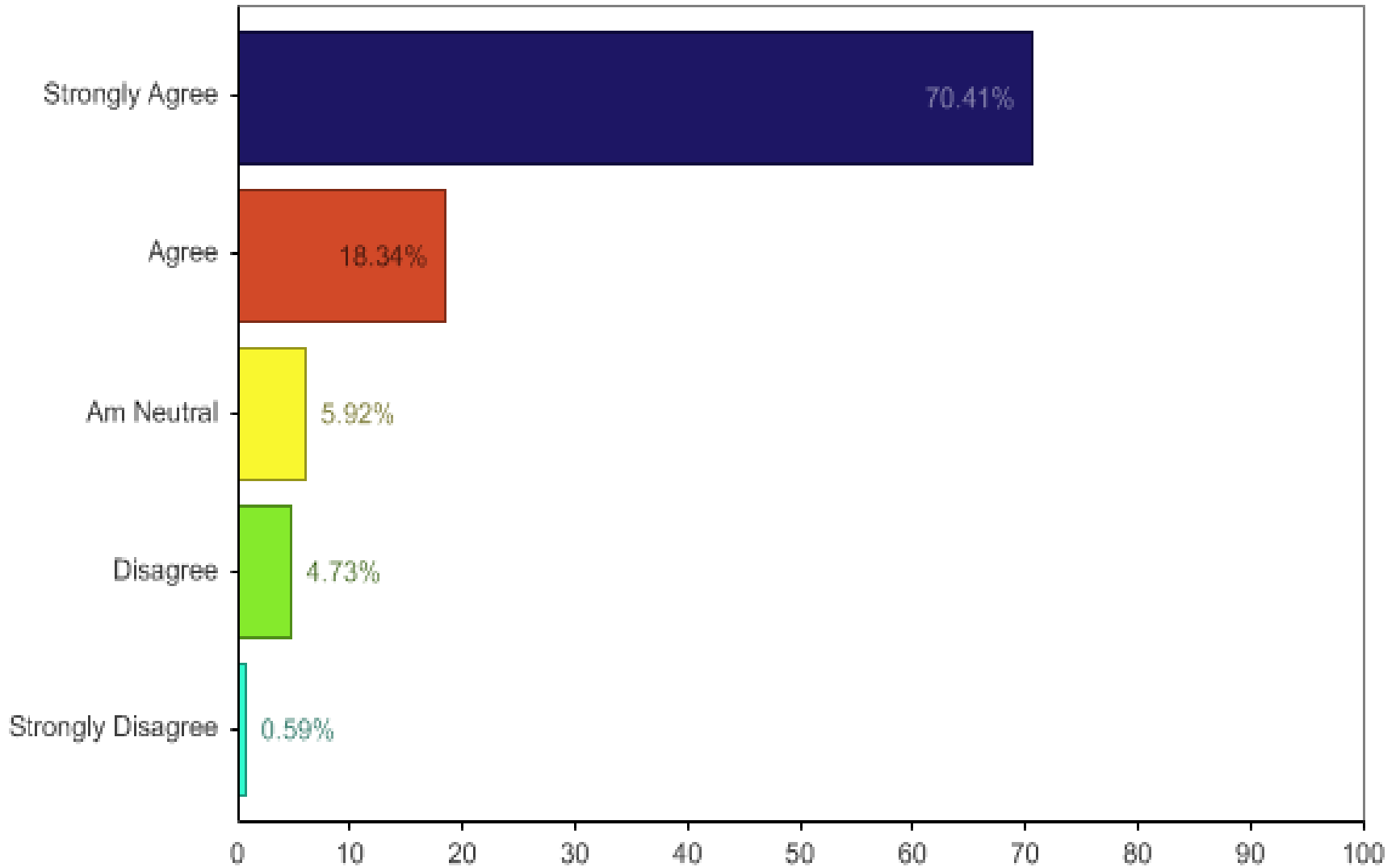
2. We need a plan... To develop land at a pace consistent with growth in population and housing.



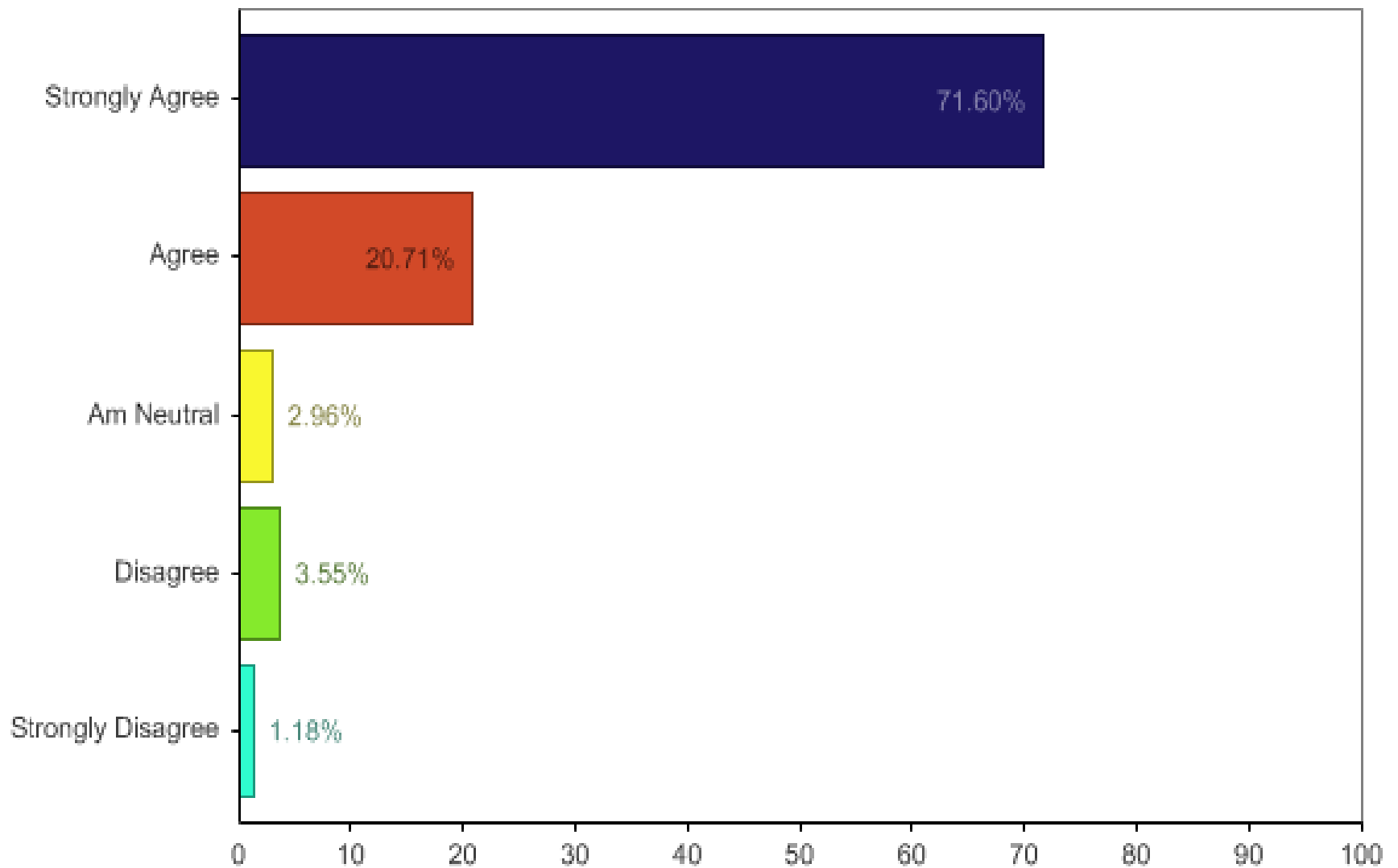
