NOTICE

This Notice is given by Robert S. McCord, Secretary of the Maryland Department of Planning, (i) acting pursuant to the Proclamation of Governor Lawrence J. Hogan, Jr. (the “Governor”) dated March 5, 2020 proclaiming a state of emergency and a catastrophic health emergency related to COVID-19, as it may be amended from time to time (the “State of Emergency”), and the Order of the Governor dated March 12, 2020 entitled “Extending Certain Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Other Governmental Authorizations, and Authorizing Suspension of Legal Time Requirements,” as may be amended from time to time, and (ii) after finding that the action described herein will not endanger the public health, welfare, or safety.

Under Md. Code Ann., Nat. Res. § 3-1018(b)—(c) (“NR § 3-1018”), local jurisdictions in Maryland that “experience nuisance flooding” are: (i) required by October 1, 2020 to “develop a plan to address nuisance flooding;” (ii) publish the plan on the jurisdiction’s website; and (iii) submit a copy of the plan to the Department of Planning (the “Department”). The deadline under NR § 3-1018 of October 1, 2020 to develop a nuisance flooding plan and to subsequently publish the plan and submit a copy of the plan to the Department is hereby extended to the later of (i) October 1, 2020 or (ii) the 30th day after the date on which the State of Emergency is terminated. Any effect of NR § 3-1018 that is inconsistent with the foregoing is hereby suspended.

This Notice is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until 30 days after the State of Emergency has been terminated.
