- + 600 square miles in size
- + 789,814 residents, 3rd largest in State
- + No incorporated municipalities
- + 328,959 housing units, 2nd largest in State
- + 1990 – 2000 population increased by 62,000 residents
- + 2000 – 2010 population increased by 35,000 residents.
- + 3,500 new residents per year, 9 new residents per day.
- + Population is diverse, 538,230 white, 202,618 African American, 34,185 Asian, 26,380 Hispanic.

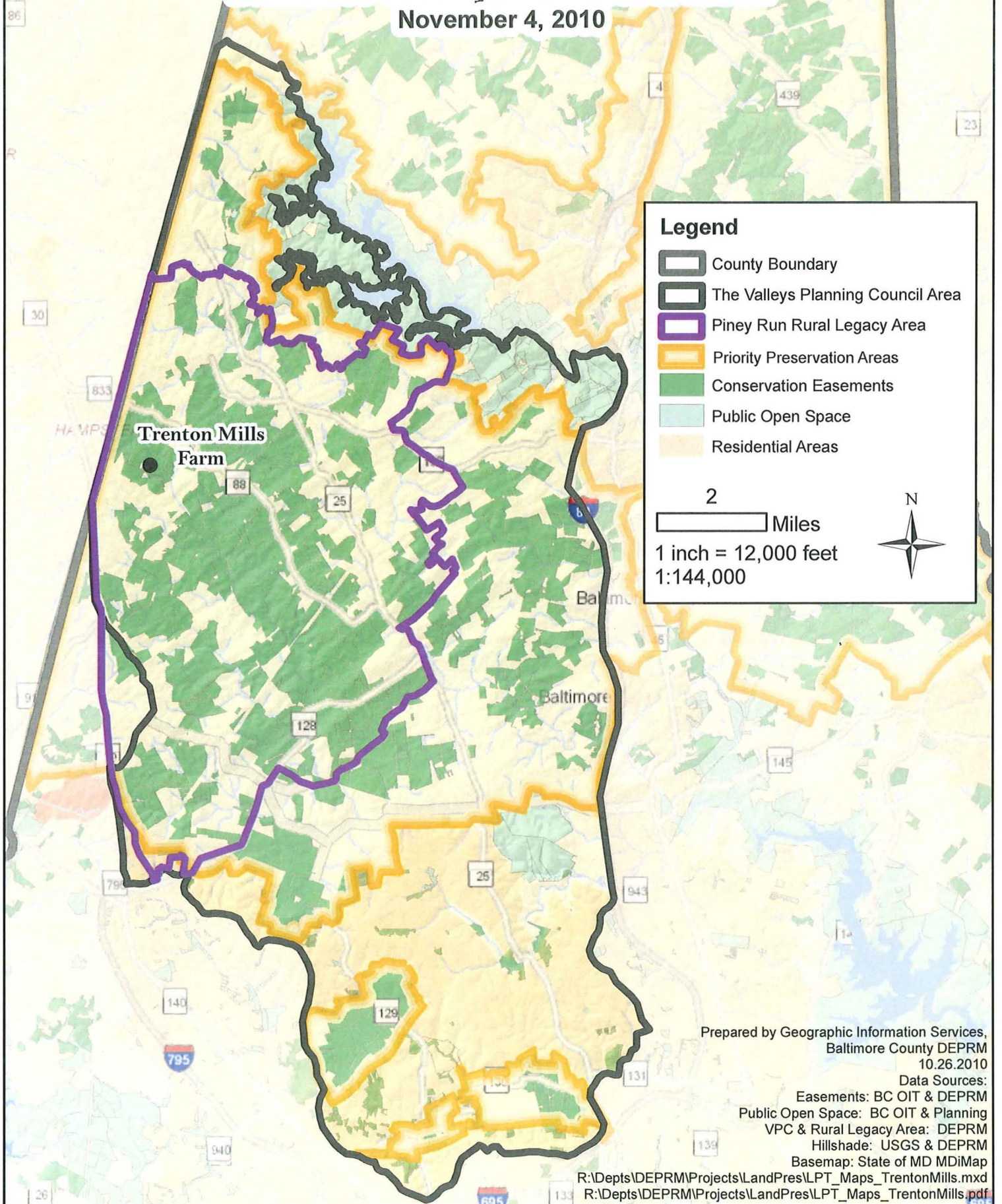
