Subject: Report on MSGC APFO Workgroup

Workgroup Participants: Frank Hertsch, Chair, Greg Bowen, and David Dahlstrom

The APFO Workgroup is working to convene a meeting of an expanded membership of the APFO workgroup. Several jurisdictions with active APFO reporting, and MACo, have been approached for participation on the workgroup. Expanded membership will provide the technical expertise needed to address improvements in the APFO process, including issues associated with coordinating cross-jurisdictional impacts and unified modeling or reporting techniques. MDP staff is updating the inventory of APFOs in Maryland to incorporate any local changes to APFO standards that occurred in 2013. MDP staff anticipates completing updates to its APFO report worksheet prior to the end of this year. These updates are intended to promote greater reporting consistency between the APFO jurisdictions that are due by July 1, 2014. MDP will continue to coordinate with MDOT and other public facility providers to share public facility capacity and utilization rates.
