Introduction

The Housing Maryland policy framework establishes a nexus between sustainable housing and health, transportation, education, as well as other critical community concerns statewide. The integration of these concerns has been divided into policies, objectives, strategies and implementation items, as noted in the December 2012 report. Upon approval of the impending draft, DHCD staff will engage the following next steps.

Implementation Items

 Review the policy framework to identify DHCD initiatives currently being implemented or co-sponsored. This will establish a baseline of housing and housing-related programs that are already in the implementation phase.

Set Priorities

Establish priorities derived from the selected implementation items.

Research Model Programs, Practices, and Processes

• Explore and examine models and best practices across the nation that has produced effective and meaningful outcomes. Adapt new knowledge and practices to our selected priorities.

Legislation

• Examine all of Housing Maryland's implementation items to determine if there are opportunities to propose enabling legislation.
