The workgroup is creating a snapshot inventory and GIS map(s) of public school, water and wastewater, and roadway capacities in the Priority Funding Area. Utilizing the most current data available, draft maps were prepared, in June, for all public schools and major wastewater facilities. Staff is currently working to refine the draft maps to increase their legibility; increase the clarity of the existing levels of capacity within the PFA boundaries; and distinguish between jurisdictions with and without APFOs. Staff anticipates that this process will take at least an additional 30 days. Staff is also working with SHA to provide similar data for state roads.
