Subject: Report on MSGC APFO Workgroup

## Workgroup Participants: Frank Hertsch, Chair, Greg Bowen, and David Dahlstrom

The workgroup is creating a snapshot inventory and GIS map(s) of public school, water and wastewater, and roadway capacities in the Priority Funding Area. Initial results are anticipated by the end of May. For schools, the state-rated capacity is being used to identify the capacity levels of existing elementary, middle and high schools within the PFA. For water and wastewater, the reported flows will be utilized. For state roads, the level of congestions will be utilized. There are limitations on the available data. The most current data is from the 2012 and 2013. It is anticipated that the inventory and mapping can begin to identify the general level of available public facility capacity. Additional analysis will be needed to identify current and planned public facility capacity improvements, and adopted level of service standards variations.
