WHAT IS A STATE DEVELOPMENT PLAN

State law* says,

(a) The Department (Planning) shall prepare and from time to time revise a plan or plans for development of the State.

(b) The Department shall prepare the Plan to promote the general welfare and prosperity of the people of the State through the coordinated development of the State.

*State Finance & Procurement Article 5-602

A BETTER MARYLAND: OBJECTIVES





- Objectives:
 - Support existing communities
 - Create quality places
 - Coordinate state investment
 - Natural resource preservation
 - Cultural, historical and heritage preservation
 - Provide information and data to support to local jurisdiction decisions



- What the plan is <u>not</u>:
 - Cannot be used to deny a State-issued permit or State funding
 - Does not supersede local planning and zoning
 - Does not supersede any local ordinance or regulations
 - Does not prevent local funding of a project
 - Cannot require a local government to change or alter a local ordinance, regulation, or comprehensive plan.



- Why are we here:
 - To engage and connect with the public, local governments, state agencies and other stakeholders across the state of Maryland and
 - To solicit their feedback on what should be included in the plan and how the plan can help state agencies and local governments plan 'A Better Maryland.'







GARRETT COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN


2008 Garrett County Comprehensive Plan

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Map 3.4: Proposed Land Use Plan Map










