Established by the Maryland General Assembly in 2010, the Maryland Sustainable Growth Commission carries out actions and makes recommendations in support of the State Economic Growth, Resource Protection, and Planning Policy. The Commission's Rural Economies Workgroup focuses on creating and sustaining a strong and vibrant economy in Maryland's many rural jurisdictions. Without a strong forestry sector, Maryland's rural populations will lose jobs and rural property owners potentially could see reductions in property values, as well as impacts to the state's forested landscape which is critical to the Bay's health.

The Commission strongly supports the Department of Natural Resources' efforts to develop an economic strategy for furthering the production and use of forest products in Maryland.
