Day 1: Fishing Fun at Kings Landing Park

Sign location: Fishing Pier

Morning: Start your day bright and early at Kings Landing Park. This picturesque park is a hidden gem for fishing enthusiasts. Whether you're a seasoned angler or a beginner, the serene waters of the Patuxent River are perfect for casting your line. Persons 16 or older are required to have a valid Maryland Chesapeake Bay & Coastal Sport Fishing License. On your way to the park, be sure to look out for the Crossed Kayaks barn quilt on Huntingtown Road. Check out the <u>Calvert County Barn Quilt Trail</u> for a complete list of locations.

Afternoon: After a morning of fishing, enjoy a picnic lunch at one of the park's scenic picnic areas. Then, explore the park's nature trails and keep an eye out for local wildlife. Be sure to check out the wayside exhibits, funded by the Chesapeake Bay Gateways Network and learn more about the significance of the Patuxent River and the wildlife that depends on it. After lunch, take a 15-minute drive to enjoy some family fun at a local bowling alley or other activity.

Evening: Wrap up your day with a relaxing evening by the river, watching the sunset over the water. Kings Landing Park offers a serene and peaceful atmosphere that will leave you feeling rejuvenated. Hungry? Stop by a local restaurant nearby for delicious food in a colorful and fun atmosphere.

Day 3: Kayaking Adventure at Lower Marlboro Wharf

Sign Location: Wharf

Morning: Spend your morning at Lower Marlboro Wharf, a perfect spot for kayaking and canoeing. Bring your own or rent equipment from local outfitters. Paddle along the calm waters of the Patuxent River and explore its scenic shoreline.

Afternoon: Enjoy a leisurely lunch by the water or enjoy fishing from the pier. Persons 16 or older are required to have a valid Maryland Chesapeake Bay & Coastal Sport Fishing License. Later on in the afternoon stop by a microbrewery that uses local ingredients.

Evening: Wrap up your Patuxent Challenge adventure with a sunset paddle on the river. As you glide along the water, take in the peaceful ambiance and the natural beauty that surrounds you. Stop by a local restaurant for mouthwatering home cooking to round out your day.
