

Description of the Data

What is the American Community Survey (ACS)? What are Five-Year Estimates?

The American Community Survey (ACS) is a nationwide survey designed to collect demographic, social, economic, and housing data every year. The U.S. Census Bureau releases data from the ACS in the form of both single-year and multiyear estimates. Unlike previous Census Bureau data products, the ACS is not concerned with creating population counts, but with collecting data on population characteristics. In the past, population characteristics were collected every ten years through the “long form” of the decennial census, which was sent to a sample of the total population (approximately one in six households in 2000). The ACS replaces this form with a program that initially sampled 250,000 unique housing unit addresses per month, or 3 million per year. The sampling rate has since been increased with the 2015 ACS sampling 3.54 million unique address. But even after five years of accumulated sampling, the ACS will still have a smaller sample size than the decennial census, which makes it important to pay attention to margins of error associated with these estimates (see “What is a Margin of Error” below).

This rolling sample allows population characteristics for large areas (those over 65,000 in population) to be reported yearly, instead of once every ten years under the previous “long form” system. Characteristics for areas containing less than 65,000 persons, are reported as five-year period estimates. These differences from the decennial census mean that ACS data are more timely, but cannot be used to pinpoint a particular point in time (unlike the decennial census, which is for April 1st of the census year). What is a Margin of Error (MoE)?

Because the ACS is a sample of a population, its results are subject to sampling error. This error also existed in the previous “long form” but due to the larger sample size it was generally not reported by the Census Bureau. Because of the methodology and the smaller sample sizes used to create the ACS, the reported data may have larger errors than experienced data users are used to seeing. The Census Bureau now reports a margin of error (MoE) based on a 90 percent confidence level that allows data users to understand just how accurate the data are and how that should be used. Generally, five-year period estimates will have a smaller MoE than one-year estimates. Estimates with too few sample cases to create a reliable estimate are marked with the letter “N” in the tables. 



Median Household Income by 2012 Legislative District, 2016-2020




Percent Foreign Born by 2012 Legislative District, 2016-2020


Percent of People in Poverty by 2012 Legislative District, 2016-2020


Percent of People Age 65+ in Poverty by 2012 Legislative District, 2016-2020






Percent of Population Who Speak English Less Than Very Well by 2012 Legislative District, 2016-2020




Percent of Families With Related Children Less Than 18 Years Old in Poverty by 2012 Legislative District, 2016-2020




Percent of Population Age 25+ With a Bachelor's Degree or Higher by 2012 Legislative District, 2016-2020




Percent of Households Receiving Food Stamps/SNAP Benefits by 2012 Legislative District, 2016-2020
