

# MULTI-STATE CENSUS VIEW 2000

Multi-State Census View 2000 CD-ROM enables users to identify and select 2000 Census geographic layers of interest in Maryland, Delaware, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, North Carolina, Virginia, West Virginia, Connecticut and the District of Columbia, and generate 5 pages of profiles containing 2000 Census Population, Household, and Housing Characteristics from SF1 and 2000 Census Social, Economic and detailed Housing Characteristics from SF3.

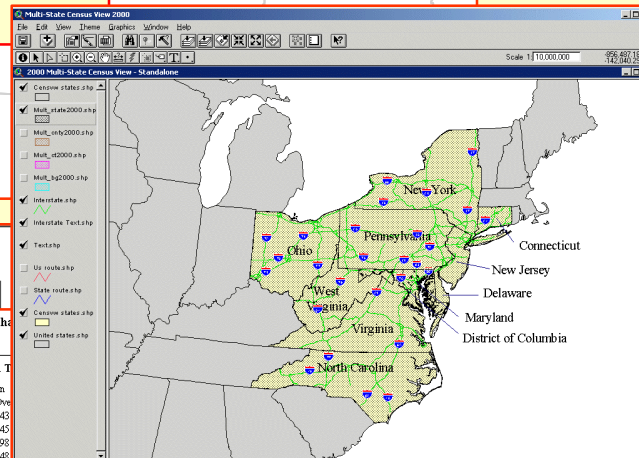
## Key Benefits to Multi-State Census View 2000:

- Multi-State CensVw00 contains the 2000 Census; Geographic layers (States, Counties, Census Tracts, & Block Groups), for 10 States and the District of Columbia.
- The ability to generate [5 Profile Pages](#) for any selected area(s) in a geographic layer.

Multi-State Census View 2000 also allows the creation of profiles for distinct [User Defined Areas](#). A user can define a study area by selecting and aggregating census tracts to produce the 5 profile pages. For example, a user might like to create the profiles for a potential marketing area that includes parts of several states.

Also available on the CD-ROM are files for calculating density for various geographic levels. These files contain land and water area in square meters and square miles.
