In addition to her work with the Census Bureau, Noemi teaches GIS and data visualization courses at Johns Hopkins University and Temple University.


She attended the Geography programs at Syracuse University and CUNY Hunter College.





How different segments of the population are making gains or are impacted by the pandemic or the recent economic recession






Income and Poverty Report

- The official poverty rate in 2020 was 11.4%
- There were 37.2 million people in poverty
- Real median household income decreased 2.9%
- Number of full-time, year-round workers decreased by approx. 13.7 million







